- 3. The Buddha is often mentioned in the commentary as the "Unique Being". What are the unique qualities & virtues of the Buddha that make Him excel above all other religious leaders & teachers during His period. Discuss.

- 4. The Buddha said "Sabbe Sankhara Aniccati", then with this wisdom, one discerns, then one is disgusted with ill, this is the path to Purity. Explain clearly how a person practising Dhamma can come to realization with wisdom of the verses uttered by the Buddha.
- 5. What are the 'Seven Factors of Enlightenment'? Explain clearly how this 'Seven Factors' of Enlightenment will lead us to enlightenment to the realization of Nibbana.
- 6. What are the Ten Fetters (Dasa Samyojana)? Explain clearly how one may eradicate these fetters with the practice of Silā, Samādhi & Pañña to lead us to attain Arahantship.

- 7. What are the qualities & virtues of Ven. Rahula Thero? Take an extract from the Rahulovada Sutta from Majjhima Nikaya to explain the qualities & virtues.
- 8. Narrate clearly the principle events in the life of Ven. Maha Kassapa Thero from the ordination of bhikkhu until his last day of Nibbana.
- 9. What are the Nine Virtues of the Sangha? Explain clearly the Nine Virtues of the Sangha and give a Jataka story from the life of the Sangha on any one incident to show the one virtue of the Sangha.
